



IMPORTANT INFO

Packing List

You will be allowed to bring only the following: a **small** suitcase or duffle bag, a backpack, pillow, and a sleeping bag with you. There is limited room on the bus and in the cabins, so please stick with the packing list essentials.

- Sleeping bag
- Fitted sheet
- Pillow
- Dirty Clothes bag
- Extra trash bags
- Flashlight
- Overalls, jeans, or workpants
- Bring **two** work outfits. (*Work clothes will be washed*)
- Safety goggles
- 2 Pair of Work gloves (*you will use them!*)
- Bible, Pen, Notebook/Journal (pack in 'bus' bag)**
- Warm Jacket
- Warm Hat
- Bandana
- Raingear (*just in case*)
- Socks (plenty)/Underwear/PJs
- Old pants/shirts
- Sweatshirt(s)
- Work boots or shoes
- Alternate pair of shoes
- One or two regular outfits for town
- Toiletries (toothbrush, shampoo, deodorant etc.)
- Shower towel
- Travel meal money (5 or 6 meals—around \$50)
- Money for souvenirs (Parents' discretion) (The camp will have t-shirts for sale.)

- **NO CELL PHONES, IPODS, OR ELECTRONICS OF ANY KIND (even while traveling)!!!**
- Travel snacks are ok. NO food will be allowed in the cabins.
- Leave prescription medicines out of your bag to be turned in upon arrival. They will be administered at meals.
- Pack your Bible in backpack to have with you on the bus.
- The weather in east Tennessee can vary greatly in March. Average high temp for the area is 61, low 34. Our goal is to try to pack as conservatively as possible, but to be ready for any possible situation. We are going to be tucked away in the woods, so we don't have many people to impress with our looks! We can wear our clothes more than one day in a row and it is OK if they stink a little! Space is VERY limited.
